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# 2021-2022 PUBLIC HEALTH PROTOCOLS

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## Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

- Follow normal protocols per the family handbook. Any child with a fever, vomiting, or contagious symptoms (e.g., pink eye, strep, the flu, etc.) must be kept home.
- If a student presents ill at school and has a temperature above 100° F, the student (and any siblings) will be sent home and not permitted to board the bus. The student and any siblings must remain at home until it is medically determined that the students are clear to return to school.

## Face Covering

- Optional for students and staff in school buildings, on school buses, and at extracurricular activities.

## Social Distance

- Social distancing in classrooms and school buildings when appropriate and feasible.

## Cleaning and Sanitizing

- Hand sanitizer provided in all classrooms, common areas, and school buses.
- Daily cleaning of high-touch surfaces in school buildings.
- School buses will be disinfected after each morning and afternoon route.

## Quarantine

- Any student or staff member who tests positive for COVID-19 will be required to quarantine in accordance with the CDC and SDH guidelines.

## Communication

- Parents/guardians will receive an email notification if a positive COVID-19 case is identified in their student's classroom, school bus, or athletic team.
