

2022-2023 PUBLIC HEALTH PROTOCOLS

General Health Protocols

- Follow normal protocols per the family handbook. Any child with a fever above 100° F, vomiting, or contagious symptoms (e.g., pink eye, strep, the flu, etc.) must be kept home.
- If a student presents ill at school and has a temperature above 100° F, the student will be sent home and not permitted to board the bus.
- Students must remain at home until they are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications like Tylenol or Motrin and symptoms are improving.
 Children with vomiting or diarrhea should be kept home for 24 hours after symptoms have stopped.
- Any student or staff member who tests positive for COVID-19 is required to isolate in accordance with the CDC and SDH guidelines.

Cleaning and Sanitizing

- Hand sanitizer provided in all classrooms, common areas, and school buses.
- Daily cleaning of high-touch surfaces in school buildings.
