### Upper School Science Teacher Grades 7-12

Treasure Valley Classical Academy (TVCA) is seeking an Upper School Science Teacher for multiple grade levels grades 7-12. In the coming year, this teacher will teach upper-level Physics and additional science and/or courses in mathematics, contingent upon the background of the candidate. An ideal candidate will have a strong background in physics, preferably holding a subject matter-specific graduate degree, and may have experience teaching in a classical school. Candidates should model for their students a love for learning and effective and elevated communication.

TVCA is a tuition-free public charter school serving grades K–12. The elementary curriculum includes explicit phonics, traditional grammar instruction, literature, history, science, Singapore Math, and Latin and Greek roots. Great books and Socratic discussion begin in the upper elementary grades. Art, music, PE, and foreign language courses are required K–6, with electives offered in the upper school. TVCA is a Hillsdale College member school and part of American Classical Schools of Idaho (ACSI).

Prospective teachers should have a strong academic foundation, exemplary character, and a genuine love of learning, along with a desire to educate the next generation of citizens. While prior experience in classical education is not required, successful candidates will be eager to learn and faithfully implement the culture, curriculum, and instructional practices of an American classical school. Idaho law enables charter schools to certify their own teachers, so teacher certification is not required for initial hire.

Applicants should submit a cover letter, a statement of educational philosophy (500 words or fewer), a résumé or *curriculum vitae*, and college transcripts (unofficial acceptable initially).
