### Job Summary:

Treasure Valley Classical Academy is seeking a qualified Speech-Language Pathology Assistant to work under the supervision of a licensed SLP to provide direct speech and language services for the students who qualify attending TVCA.

### Key Responsibilities and Duties:

- Support clinical services provided by speech-language pathologists.
- Follows and implements documented IEP plans
- Documents student progress toward meeting established objectives, and reports the information to the SLP
- Conducts speech and language screenings, without interpretation, and using screening protocols developed by the supervising Speech and Language Pathologist (SLP)
- Assists the SLP during assessments
- Assists with formal documentation, preparing materials, and performing clerical duties
- Prepares therapy materials and/or equipment for use in the classroom and therapy activities
- Assists in maintaining student records, tallying data, preparing charts, records, graphs, and reports

Knowledge of:

Speech and language pathology equipment, materials, and procedures;  
Normal speech, language, and hearing development;  
Language disorders and rehabilitation;  
Articulation disorders and rehabilitation;  
Acquired disorders and rehabilitation;  
Learning patterns in children;  
Student behavior management techniques and strategies;  
Learning problems of children with special education needs;  
English usage, punctuation, spelling, grammar, and math;  
Routine recordkeeping.

Qualifications:

- Education: Associate degree in an SLPA program, OR a Bachelor's degree in speech-language pathology or communication disorders.
- Clinical Experience: Successful completion of a minimum of 100 hours of supervised field work or clinical practicum.
- Certification/Competency: Demonstration of required SLPA skills and competencies, which often aligns with national ASHA (American Speech-Language-Hearing Association) requirements.
- State Licensure: You must apply for and receive your license from the [Idaho Speech, Hearing and Communication Services Licensure Board](#) prior to beginning employment
